Wareham Fire District

The Wareham Fire District (District) is seeking to fill the position of Fire Chief/Chief Engineer. The Department provides Fire and Rescue services as well as assisting Town EMS services with a 58 member staff consisting of 29 Career Personnel, 26 Call Personnel, 1 Mechanic, and 2 Administrative staff. In 2020 the Department responded to 2458 incidents. The Annual budget is \$3,860,004 Dollars for Fiscal Year 2022.

The Fire Chief is appointed by the Prudential Committee and reports directly to the Committee.

A Bachelors Degree in Fire Science, Fire Protection Engineering, Public Administration, or related discipline, with a minimum of 10 years of progressive experience in a Career Fire Department is preferred, and at least 5 years as a command officer or equivalent combination of education, training and experience.

Candidates must have demonstrated experience with incident command, labor relations, municipal finance, planning, human resources, technology, and community outreach.

Must demonstrate leadership skills and the ability to work effectively with the District's management team.

Salary commensurate with experience, education, and training. District By Laws require residency.
